



## **(WSI) – Water Safety Instructor Certification**

Teach other individuals how to be safe around water and/or swim  
Use swim program materials effectively  
Plan and conduct effective swim/safety courses  
Evaluate progress of students for certification  
Prepare and submit accurate records and reports

### **Requirements:**

To participate in the Water Safety Instructor course, individuals must:

Be at least 16 years of age on or before the final scheduled session of this course- please have identification when signing up for course.

### **Must be able to demonstrate the ability to perform the following swimming skills:**

- Front crawl-25 yards
- Back crawl-25 yards
- Breaststroke-25 yards
- Elementary backstroke-25 yards
- Sidestroke-25 yards
- Butterfly-15 yards
- Maintain position on back 1 minute in deep water (floating or sculling)
- Tread water for 1 minute

***You must be able to pass all required prerequisites to participate in the course***

### **Items that you are responsible for bringing with you to class are:**

Swim suit, towel and goggles

Notebook and pencil or pen

Once you have received your books bring them daily

Bring a packed lunch (there will be a 1 hour lunch each day)
